Welcome back everyone!

We're really excited to start another fun half term full of new things to learn and explore. In Science, we'll be learning all about animals, starting with tiny creatures called minibeasts.

We'll be finding out about invertebrates - animals without backbones - and discovering where they live, how they move, and what makes them special. In History, we're going back in time to learn about castles! We'll explore what life was like in a castle and compare it to the homes we live in today. In PSHE, we're learning all about friendships and how to be a good

we're learning all about friendships and how to be a good friend. We'll talk about what makes someone kind, how we can help each other, and how to work and play together happily. We can't wait to see everything the children will discover and enjoy this half term!



What we will be learning about:

- Minibeasts Learning about different types of minibeasts, their features, and the habitats they live in.
- Castles Comparing homes now and in the past, discovering who lived in castles, and identifying key features like towers and drawbridges.
- Relationships— Talking about friendships and learning how to be a kind, respectful, and supportive friend.
- Places of Worship Exploring different places of worship such as churches, mosques and temples and learning why they are special to different faiths.
- Weaving Exploring basic weaving techniques using paper, fabric, or natural materials.
- Length, Height, and Capacity—Measuring and comparing objects by their length, height, and capacity using standard and non-standard units.
- Expanding Sentences—Using conjunctions such as and, but, because, and so to make our sentences longer and more interesting.

- Encouraging your children to give reasons for their ideas
- Encouraging your children to practise expanding their sentences using conjunctions when writing
