## The children will be learning about:

- Continents and oceans in geography
- Animals, including humans in science
- Painting in art and mechanisms in DT
- Gymnastics and hoopball in PE
- Digital Photography in computing
- Online Bullying and Managing Online Information in internet safety
- How new life is welcomed and How we can make good choices in RE
- Celebrating Differences in PSHE
- Addition and subtraction in maths

#### The children will:

- Learn about how animals change as they grow
- Explore colour mixing and learn about Wassily Kandinsky
- Learn about the different human and physical features of the continents and talk about which continent they would like to visit
- Think about how they are different from each other and how this makes them special
- Learn how to add and subtract two 2digit numbers

## You can help by:

- Reading with your child regularly and discussing the book they read.
- Practising the spellings your child brings home in their spelling book.
- Encouraging your child to speak in full sentences.
- Encouraging your child to practise writing simple sentences with capital letters and full stops.

### Things to remember:

- Bookbags should be brought into school each Thursday with their reading record.
- Children receive homework every Friday and it is checked the following Thursday.
- Outdoor learning lessons are on Mondays. Children should bring appropriate clothing for the weather.
- 2FW have PE on Monday and Thursday. 2VW have PE on Thursday. Children should come to school in their PE kit—white t-shirt, black shorts and trainers. For cooler weather they can wear a black tracksuit.
