The children will be learning about:

- Writing a setting narrative in writing
- Hot and cold places in geography
- Pop art in art
- Football and hoop ball in PE
- Making music in computing
- Managing online information in internet safety
- How and why do some people pray in RE.
- Healthy me in PSHE
- Multiplication, division, mass, capacity and temperature in maths
- Living things and their habitats in science

You can help by:

- Reading with your child regularly and discussing the book they read.
- Practising the spellings your child brings home in their spelling book.
- Encouraging your child to speak in full sentences.
- Encouraging your child to practise writing simple sentences with capital letters and full stops.
- Supporting your child with correct letter and number formation.

The children will:

- Write their own setting narrative.
- Learn how to use suffixes *ful* and *less* and apostrophes for possession to add more detail to their writing.
- Add, make and share equal groups in maths..
- Where do animals live and where do they get their food from.
- Explore pop art and learn about Roy Lichtenstein.
- Learn about hot and cold places.
- Think about healthy food choices.

Things to remember:

- Bookbags should be brought into school **each Thursday** with their reading record.
- Outdoor learning lessons are on Tuesdays. Children should bring appropriate clothing for the weather.
- 2FW have PE on Monday and 2VW have PE on Thursday. Children should come to school in their PE kit—white t-shirt, black shorts and trainers. For cooler weather they can wear a black tracksuit.
